RÉSUMÉ

TEACHING

Adolf Sotoca is Professor Serra Hunter of the Urbanism Department at the School of Architecture at UPC **Barcelona**TECH. His commitment to teaching covers different types of courses and a diverse thematic scope:

- Theory courses and Architecture & Urban Design Studios.
- Diverse disciplinary fields: Architecture, Urban Design and Theory of the City.
- Several Programs, from Bachelor to Master and PhD levels.

He has frequently been a coordinator and responsible for these courses. He has enriched contents with his own research background, establishing a permanent transfer between research and teaching. Prof. Adolf Sotoca is currently **Visiting Professor** at the Cracow University of Technology (Poland) and at the Universidad Técnica Particular de Loja (Ecuador). He was also **Visiting Associate Professor** for the AY 2013-14 at the School of Architecture of the **University of Illinois at U-C** where taught Design Studio in Urbanism and Preservation and was at work in close relationship with the City of Chicago and is researching and teaching theory and history of American urbanism.

Since 2008 students have repeatedly evaluated him with a ranking over 4,3/5 (mean for Architecture courses in UPC = 3,6). He has been the highest rated professor of Urbanism Department at UPC_BarcelonaTECH for the Academic Years 2011, 2013 and 2015. Students at the University of Illinois rated him as 4,8/5 in 2014.

Adolf Sotoca has partaken in several programs of the most relevant architecture education institutions in Europe: IUAV (Venezia), Berlage Institute (Rotterdam), PoliMI (Milan), ETHZ (Zurich), UAUIM (Bucharest) and TUD (Darmstadt). The European Union-University Secretariat appointed him as Exchange Professor at Cracow University of Technology for the AY 2011-12 (European Architecture Education Excellence Program).

His teaching activity has been acknowledged in several occasions. In 2010 his task as Master Thesis advisor was awarded with the "T&R City Award", issued by the Regional Government of Catalonia. In September of 2012, he received the "Honorable Mention for Teaching Quality", granted by the UPC_BarcelonaTECH and the Agency for the Quality of the University System of Catalonia. In 2014 the students at the University of Illinois at U-C ranked him as Excellent Professor (published at "Daily Illini" on March 19.)

RESEARCH

Prof. Sotoca plays also a very active role in several International R&D projects:

- He is Prometeo researcher for the Government of Ecuador (SENESCYT) for the period 2015-2017, where he leads the project URVA-MEDD on water & energy network design in urban development.
- He was Thematic Expert of the URBACT program and works for the USEACT project, funded by the European Commission and supported by ten different European municipalities.
- He was also researcher of the CRECE Program, funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science (2013-15)
- He is lead researcher of the Projects "Low density sustainable urban patterns", funded by AGAUR for the three years period 2011-14 and INCREC funded for the two-year period 2009-11.
- He is also a member of the Research Group in Urbanism (GRU), (AGAUR 2009-13 and 2014-16).

Prof. Adolf Sotoca's research began in 2002, when he won the competitive FI AGAUR Fellowship. In 2006, he presented his PhD dissertation, graded with an Excellent Cum Laude by an International Jury. His post-doctorate research deepened into the topic of obsolete modern residential settlements and he opened a new research field on **Urban Growth Containment Strategies and Policies**. He actively participates in the PhD Program in Urbanism, which is one of the two PhD Programs of Excellence granted by the Ministry of Education and Science of Spain.

The outcomes of his research, focused on **Urban Regeneration** as well as on **Water & Energy networks**, have been published in the proceedings of a dozen peer-review international conferences (five of them being considered "Notable Conferences" according to the EU quality criteria), seven books (three of them are double edition English-Spanish and English-Catalan) and ten book chapters, most of them internationally published.

Adolf Sotoca is also Editorial Board or reviewer of several indexed scientific journals (see extended CV)

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH

The international activity of the applicant covers several fields. The Ecuadorian Government appointed Professor Sotoca as <u>Prometeo</u> Researcher for the period 2015-2017, being leader for the URVA-MEDD project on **Water & Energy network in urban development**. He was also Thematic Expert of the <u>URBACT</u> program (European Union Commission), being contributor to "Integrated development of obsolete and deprived urban areas" and "Governance and Urban Planning" projects. He has been also panelist of the Expert Group of <u>UN-Habitat</u> (United Nations Commission) and member of a wide number of American and European institutions (among them <u>APA</u>, <u>EDRA</u>, <u>ENHR</u>).

He is director of the European network **RESIDE**, funded by European Commission's Erasmus Intensive Program (2010-16). RESIDE is participated by eight European universities. RESIDE has published four books and is still dynamically strengthening and expanding research and teaching goals.

Adolf Sotoca is also associated to the Educational Board of the <u>European Postgraduate Master of Urbanism</u> (EMU), being member of the review board of Master Thesis. The EMU is a consortium formed by KU Leuven, TU Delft, IUA Venice and UPC_BarcelonaTECH. He is also a member of the Executive Board of the <u>International Forum of Urbanism</u> (IFoU), a Higher Education network participated by the most prestigious universities of South East Asia and Europe. IFoU periodically organizes Scientific Conferences focused on contemporary urban themes.

Prof. Sotoca has also been Visiting Researcher at TU Darmstadt and TU Stuttgart, where he had the opportunity to hold pre-doc stays related with his PhD dissertation.

PRACTICE

Adolf Sotoca has developed a professional practice with remarkable leadership. Until 2004 he worked with acknowledged professionals in the field of urbanism, such as Giancarlo di Carlo, Joan Busquets (current Martin Bucksbaum Professor in Practice of Urban Planning and Design at the Harvard GSD), and in several Public Administrations in Catalonia. In 2005 he founded CSArchitects. His office has been in charge of several very prominent urban scale commissions, which were developed with a strong applied research approach.

Since 2005, CSArchitects has been invited to a wide range of restricted national and international competitions specially focused on **urban regeneration** and **sustainable urban growth management**. CSArchitects has been awarded with **thirteen first prizes**, two-second prizes and a special mention. CSArchitects has been a finalist in four more competitions.

Some proposals and designs by CSArchitects are published in scientific journals and institutional publications. Moreover CSArchitects participated in many scientific conferences presenting some of the works commissioned by the City Council of Barcelona. In the 2010 the particular research approach undertaken by CSArchitects was awarded with a **TALENT award**. TALENT is a program for R&D promotion in SMEs by promoting public-private partnership with the Regional Government of Catalonia.

INSTITUTIONAL & SCIENTIFIC SERVICE

Prof. Sotoca is currently ViceDean of International Relations at the School of Architecture at UPC_BarcelonaTECH. He is responsible of all international relations and he is at work in strengthening alliances with South Asian and American Higher Education institutions.

Prior to his current position he was appointed Academic Secretary of the School of Architecture at UPC_BarcelonaTECH. He was at work with the reorganization of the Academic Program for the Architecture Studies, according to the guidelines of the European Space for Higher Education affecting all Graduate, Master and PhD Programs in Architecture. He has also been Associate Director and member of the PhD Commission of the Urbanism Department at UPC_BarcelonaTECH. Adolf Sotoca has also been responsible for International Exchange Programs between ETSAB and the Schools of Architecture in Switzerland and Italy, as well as a coordinator of the Academic Professional Practices of ETSAV.
